

Greetings,

Just found out last week that the Red Cross will have a price increase on most of their courses beginning January 1st. About 20% which for most courses is about \$2-3 only. However, the Lifeguard Management course, which is about \$120 may also go up. We usually get a 50% discount code from our Red Cross Aquatic liaison, but she advised me that the discount will only be 20% beginning Jan 1st.

As I have mentioned before at the last COLA meeting, I would highly recommend this course for any and all Lifeguard Supervisors and facility managers. You do not have to be or been a lifeguard to take this online course. However, it does help.

The NJ PRB requires this online course plus an in person supplemental class and exam for NJ Pool Director certification. This is required ONLY for those facilities that have a pool. However, I again, would recommend that all aquatic managers and/or beach supervisors take the in-person class as well. I would be willing to conduct the in-person class in the late winter, very early spring for those who have completed the online course. No rush for this right now.

To take advantage of the 50% off discount from now until Jan 1st, I would suggest that you may want to send this out to our COLA members. The discount code is currently PAAQ010622.
